I am writing to you in my capacity as Minister for Grenfell Victims and on behalf of my colleague, Dominic Raab, Minister for Housing, as we would like to meet with you to discuss your housing situation.

We are deeply concerned that people affected by the fire at Grenfell Tower are still living in emergency accommodation eleven months after the fire. We have been clear that living in hotels in the long-term is not suitable and we would like to understand better the reasons preventing you from moving into more suitable accommodation. We realise that these reasons may be diverse and complex but by talking through them, we hope that we can help you to move forward.

In particular, we would like to meet with you to ensure that you are being fully supported in the rehousing process and to hear directly from you whether there is anything further you need, whether from the Council or from other organisations.

We have asked representatives from the Council's housing team and Care For Grenfell to join the meetings. An NHS representative will also be present to provide support if needed.

We will continue to work closely with the Council to support you in finding suitable accommodation.
